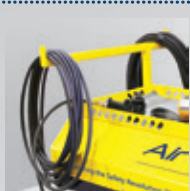

To meet this challenge United Safety developed the Air TreQ[™] Blinder. It combines a highly portable breathing air delivery system and a pneumatic power source for operating air tools in a small, mobile package.

The Air TreQ™ Blinder is a highly versatile, portable unit that can be used as a breathing air delivery system and pneumatic tool power source, making remote short-duration projects more efficient.



Airline rack: Keeps airlines off the ground to prevent tripping hazard.



Platform to safely transport required gear and tool boxes to the worksite.

Access panel for breathing air pressure settings.

"Fill-on-the-fly" technology allows refill while equipment is in use.

Handle can be replaced with pintle hitch for towing.

Breathing air delivery system provides upto 10 man hours of Class D breathing air and can supply 2 personnel.



User gauge is equipped with a low pressure alarm set at 500 psi to alert users that breathing air reserve is running low.

Pneumatic power auto-shutdown system set at 1000 psi, to ensure breathing air reserve is not compromised by tool use.

Narrow footprint and excellent maneuverability makes it ideal for constricted work areas.
